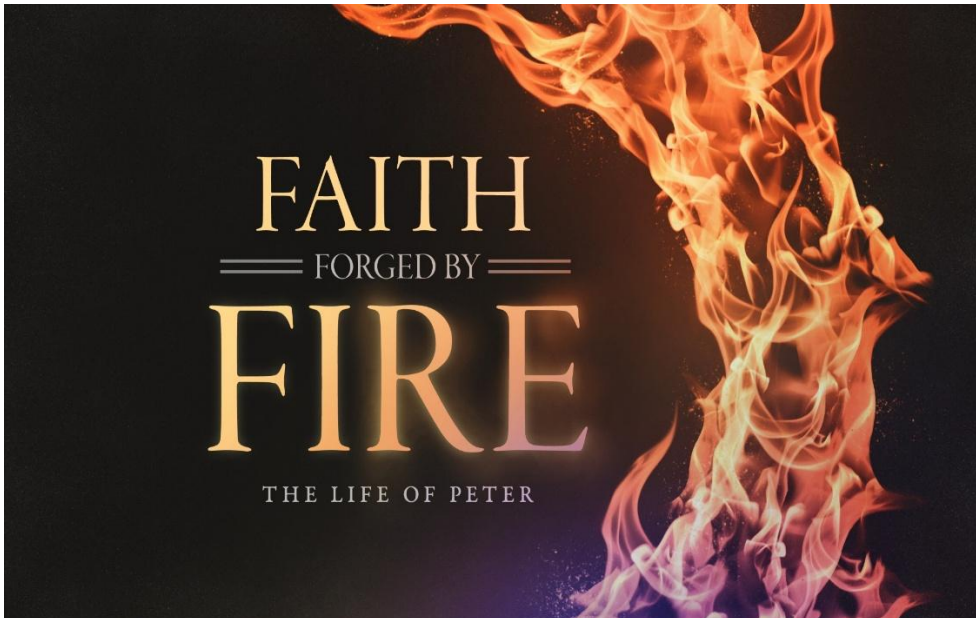




SERMON NOTES
