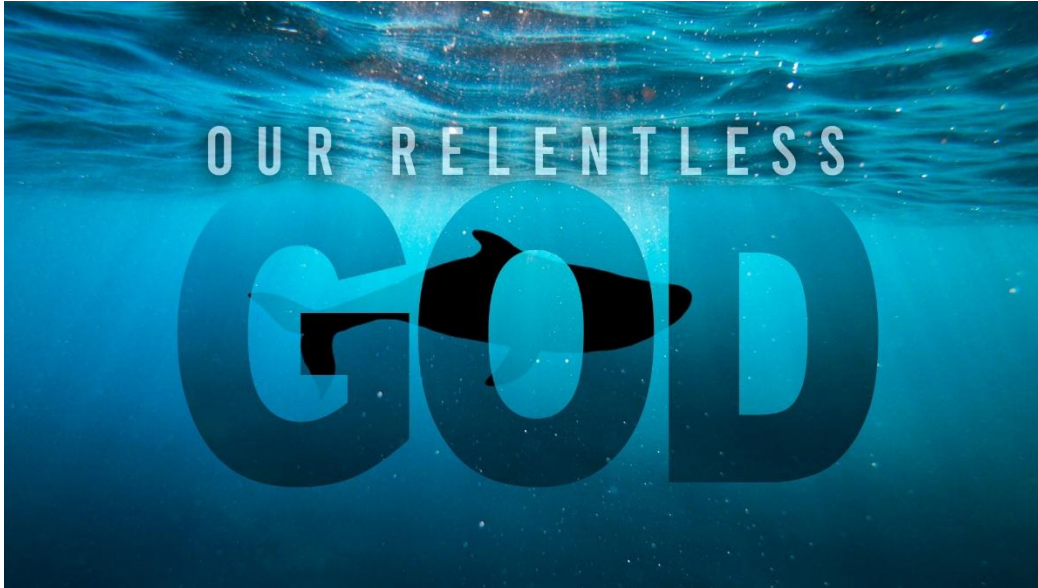




SERMON NOTES
